Blue is the colour!

SMITHFIELD 2004 will see the launch of a completely new look for all STANDEN manufactured machines, as the colour changes to Mediterranean blue across the range on all 2005 models. The board of directors made the decision to produce a more coherent look for STANDEN-PEARSON Potato Systems machinery, and STANDEN-PEARSON cultivation equipment. Blue is also popular in export markets where STANDEN-PEARSON machines are highly regarded.

The **SMITHFIELD SHOW** stand will feature a 2005 model STANDEN-PEARSON MEGASTAR stone separator, H-200 potato planter, POWAVATOR 130/70 complete with BEDFORMER, and a BASELIER cultivator.

An 'island display' will be the centrepiece of the stand, featuring four film screens, each in a dedicated segment of the island, promoting the four main areas of STANDEN activity:

1. SPRING equipment: STANDEN-PEARSON BEDFORMERS and POWAVATOR, BASELIER CULTIVATORS, MEGASTAR and MAXISTAR de-stoners, POTATO PLANTERS and 6-row WEEDER
2. HARVEST machinery; STANDEN-PEARSON FM-2 topper, BASELIER toppers, STANDEN-PEARSON QUALITY MASTER, VISION-XS and ENTERPRISE STARFLOW harvesters
3. STANDEN-PEARSON cultivation machinery including POWAVATOR and POWER-HARROW
4. STANDEN-REFLEX imported machinery: HOLMER beet tankers, SIMON vegetable harvesters, BCMH pea viners, HERRIAU precision drills, KEULMAC and MACLOUIS onion machinery

BASELIER show front

Front mounted cultivators for potato planting are becoming more and more popular, so STANDEN will be showing the latest BASELIER 3FKV-200 hook tine cultivator at SMITHFIELD. With 3-point linkages and gearbox inputs for front or rear operation, the show machine will also be fitted with BASELIER SPIKE tines, specially developed for heavier, very wet or stony soils.

MAXISTAR upgrade

2005 model STANDEN-PEARSON MAXISTAR soil separators feature a completely new axle design. To ensure clean running, the design features no cross axle or chassis members, keeping the area under the machine completely clear. An all new control console with can-bus electronics enhance adjustability and ease of operation.
